

Due to the unique schedule of the Freshman Academy, the exams schedule is slightly different from the rest of the school. Important Additional Notices:

- All students who take math during either A or B block will take their finals on either January 9th or 10th (your teacher will specify). They **WILL NOT** be required to attend regularly scheduled A or B period exam on January 11th.
- Math teachers will be available during the A and B Block during exams for students in need of additional support prior to taking finals.
- All students who take math during C block **WILL** attend their regularly scheduled math final on January 12th for the entire two hour period.

- PE, Healthy Living, Computer Apps, and other semestered, every other day classes will give finals on the last day of regular classes. Students **WILL NOT** be expected to report to school during those scheduled time periods.
- Foreign Languages will have normal 2 hour long finals during the scheduled time periods.
- Social Studies, English, and Science class have hour long finals as shown above.
- Students will need to come to all of their A, B, and C block finals ready for **BOTH** odd and even day exams. You will be required to transition between classes silently. There will be **NO** talking in the halls, **NO** stopping at the lockers, **NO** visits to the bathroom. This is imperative because we must be mindful of other students who will be in the middle of their exams.
- Students who do not have a scheduled class will be expected to move from their previous final directly to the cafeteria/library or could be picked up to go home if your schedule permits.
